

MORE BEADED EDGING TECHNIQUES

This class features live video projection allowing every student a front row seat!!

Supply List:

* 1 - 14" x 6" rectangular mock "quilt". Please bind using the double fold method, with mitered corners. Hand sew the binding to the backing using a blind or appliqué stitch (rather than machine stitching) to make the beading easier to accomplish. Aim for a binding width about 1/4", but no less than 3/8" wide - measured on the right side, from seam line to folded edge. You don't need to make an actual quilt...a "hot pad" type will do. Minimal machine quilting to hold the layers together is sufficient. A solid, light-colored fabric for quilt and binding (like muslin) will be easier to work with during this learning process. **** This item can be purchased in class for \$6.00 if you'd rather not make one.**

* needles - size #10 or #11 quilting between (or the smallest size YOU can thread) and size #10 or #11 appliqué needle (also known as Sharps or Straw Needles.)

* scissors - you'll need one that is small and sharp to the point, such as an embroidery scissors or gingham featherweight thread clips

* small shallow dish, plate, or saucer for the beads

* small ruler - 1" x 6" size is sufficient

* 3 straight pins

* pencil and paper for note taking.....OR bring a fine-line permanent pen to write notes on your quilt sampler.

* Ott light and extension cord - optional....you may end up dragging it with you only to find it's not possible to plug in due to the room set-up.....I always request nice bright classrooms....and when we are lucky....they are available!

Supply fee: \$6.00 payable to instructor is required. Kit contains beading thread and all the beads. If you wish to purchase a 'mock quilt' (instead of making one yourself), the kit fee is \$12.00.
