

QUILTS THAT STAND OUT IN A CROWD

SUPPLY LIST:

* 3/4 yard **SOLID** color 100% cotton fabric, prewash and pressed - suggest any color green, or yellows/gold/brown - keeping or fern motif in mind

NOTE: finished quilt will be 12" x 22" - fabric will be for top and backing

* quilt hoop or (Mary's preference) pvc frame (frame no larger than 11" x 17")

* removable marking pen, pencil, or chalk

* quilting thread to match fabric

* white basting thread (or inexpensive white sewing thread)

* needles - quilting between and (optional) - basting or sewing needle

* thimble

* small sharp embroidery scissors that cuts to the point

* sandwich size bag of polyester stuffing

* Scotch tape or small amount of masking tape

* Ott light and extension cord - *This is optional....you may end up dragging it with you only to find it's not possible to plug in due to the room set-up. I always request nice bright classrooms and when we are lucky they are available!

* stuffing tool (such as Turn-It-All) - DO NOT purchase especially for class!

**** students who work at a slower pace may also want to bring - 2 pieces muslin and 1 piece batting (large enough to fit your hoop or frame.) If your project doesn't reach the point where stipple quilting can begin, you'll be able to practice on the muslin layers instead. Workshops should be instructive yet fun....this option provides a stress-free day!

Kit fee required - \$5.00 - kit contains trapunto needles, inner lining fabric, cording material, and batting.

In order to make the best use of class time: Consider bringing a sewing machine to jump start this project. You can machine baste, rather than the more time consuming method of hand basting. Equip the machine with conventional sewing thread and an open-toe embroidery foot if you have one. Students can share machines.

NOTE: Instructor will provide a complimentary fern pattern. Stuffing tools, quilting between, & some pvc quilt frames will be available for purchase.
