

LOVE OF MANY COLORS

This narrow, paper string-pieced heart quilt can be hung in the most unexpected display areas; the perfect solution when your wall space is already filled with quilts! I selected an Amish palette of colors for the hearts, set off by a very black, black fabric, but feel free to coordinate your fabric selection by using solids, prints, or a combination of both in the color scheme of your abode!

Supply List: (Finished quilt 13" x 41")

42" wide fabric

- * 1 1/4 yds. black solid fabric for quilt top and binding
- * 8 fat quarters, solid fabric, each a different color for the hearts and flat piping
- * 3 pieces, 6" x 10" light-weight paper backed fusible adhesive
- * Sewing thread to match fabric (or a neutral color)
- * Decorative thread to machine appliqué the hearts (such as #30 weight rayon embroidery thread or your favorite machine embroidery thread)
- * Rotary cutter, clear acrylic rulers, and self-healing mat
- * Scissors - small sharp paper scissors, fabric scissors
- * Straight pins
- * Four 8 1/2" x 11" pieces of white paper
- * Light weight tear-away stabilizer for machine appliqué (commercial product or tissue paper/blank newsprint, etc.)
- * Pencil
- * Sewing machine, capable of a decorative or zig-zag stitch for machine appliqué. Helpful accessories to bring if you already own them: 1/4" foot, and an open-toe foot
- * Optional - machine needles - 90/14 needle for heavy weight embroidery thread
- * Extension cord if not provided in class
- * Iron and press mat if not supplied in class
- * Teflon press sheet or pressing cloth

You will need the following to complete the project, none are necessary to bring to class.

The optional beaded binding treatment will be demonstrated in class for your consideration:

- * 1 rectangle, 16" x 44", print or solid coordinating fabric for backing
- * 16" x 44" piece of batting - Hobb's Thermore is recommended when using black fabric
- * Nymo beading thread - size D
- * 2,720 - size # 11 seed beads, colors to match string-pieced hearts. Mary's sample utilized 8 colors (or values of one color such as a light and dark green). 340 size #11 seed beads were required for each color.
